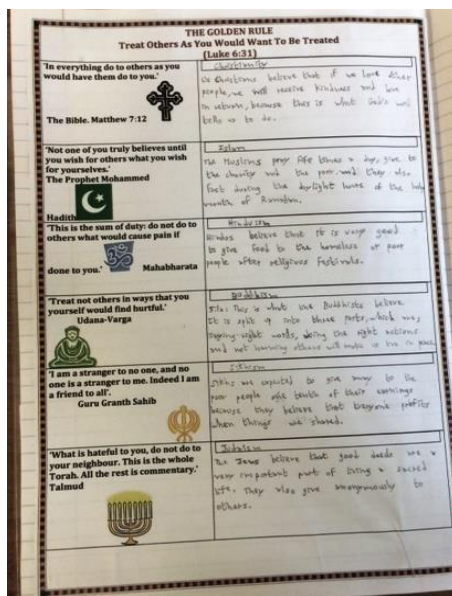

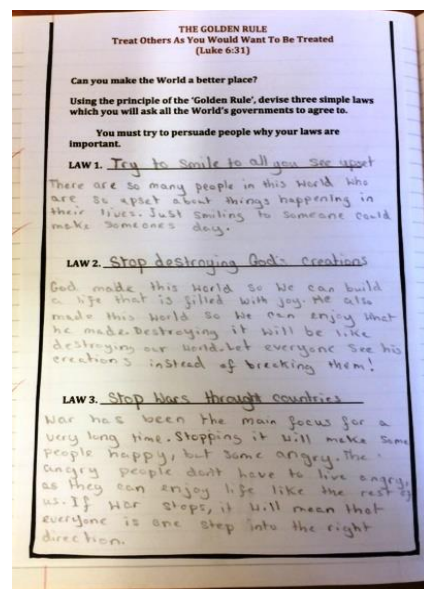
Year 6 focused on the Golden Rule

As a reminder, those clubs are:

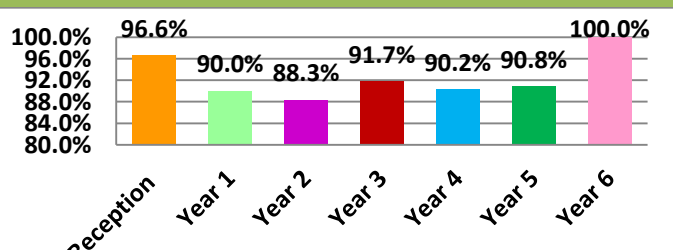
- Monday Yoga – 6 places available (Years N to 2) – Please call 0845 899 7167 to enrol
