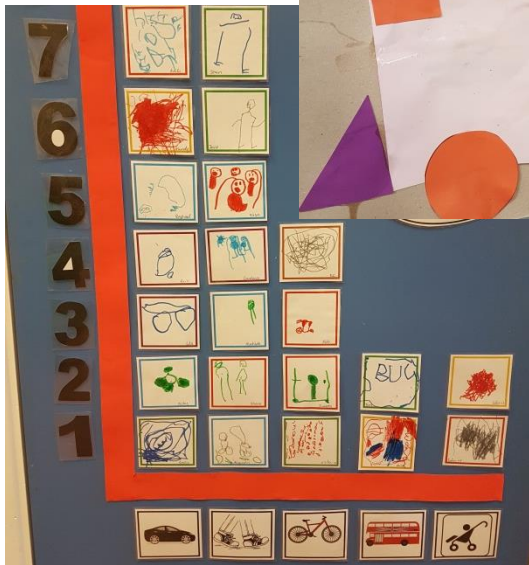
Nursery

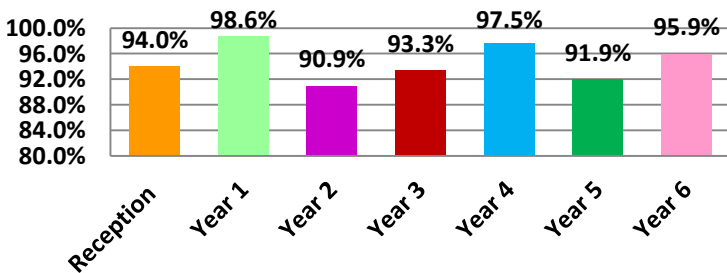
